I Meeting Called to Order

V Public Hearing on the 2013/14 School Budget

The Board welcomed the public to the budget presentation. The SBA/BS discussed the budget for the 2013/14 fiscal year. Discussions took place regarding our current purchases of technology as well as complying with EE4NJ, PARCC, etc. for 2013/14. The budget will see an increase of approximately \$5.81 per month for a home assessed at \$316,880.00. The local tax levy increase represents a 2.3% increase. Handouts were provided for review and reflected that the district received approximately \$18,000 in additional state aid. If the municipality receives the BPP tax adjustment the increase will be reduced.

3-21-13-1 **RESOLVED**, the Farmingdale Board of Education upon the recommendation of the Superintendent and SBA/BS adopted a tentative budget on February 27, 2013 to be submitted to the Executive County Superintendent of Schools for approval and the tentative budget was approved by the Executive County Superintendent of Schools on March 11, 2013 for the 2013-14 school year using the 2013-14 state aid figures (tentative budget was revised with 13/14 state aid figures at the March 13, 2013 board meeting).

RESOLVED, the tentative budget was advertised in the legal section of the Asbury Park Press on March 15, 2013 and the tentative budget was presented to the public during a public hearing on March 21, 2013.

The budget includes sufficient funds to provide curriculum and instruction, which will enable all students to achieve the Core Curriculum Content Standards, and is in compliance with N.J.S.A. 18A and N.J.A.C. Title 6A. As per NJAC 6A:23B-1.2(b), the budget provides for a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for travel and expense reimbursement. The 2013-14 budget includes a maximum travel appropriation of \$3,000.00 general fund and \$5,000.00 special revenue funds. The SBA/BS shall track and record these costs to insure that the maximum amount is not exceeded. Included in the 2013-14 budget is a maximum regular business travel amount of \$1,000.00 for specific employees.

RESOLVED, that the Farmingdale Board of Education includes in the budget the automatic waiver adjustment for increased cost of health benefits in the amount of \$4,431.00. The additional funds are included in the base budget and will be used to pay for the additional increases in health benefits.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Farmingdale Board of Education hereby adopts the 2013-2014 school year budget.
