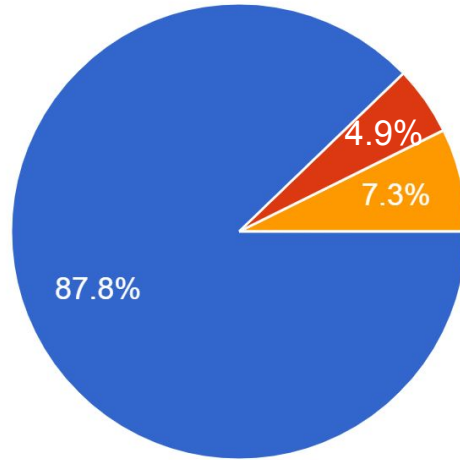

Which of the following most closely describes your intention with regards to Farmingdale School's reopening in September?

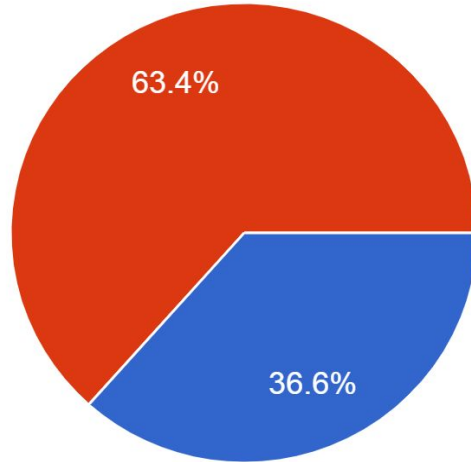

With requirements of social distancing in place, which of the following statements best describes your preference for your child's education and learning for the 2020-2021 school year?

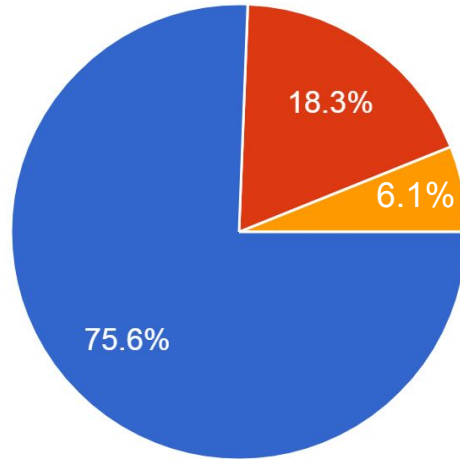

- I would like my child to attend a hybrid model of instruction. SOCIAL DISTANCING REQUIREMENTS CAN BE MET. STUDENTS ONLY NEED TO WEAR MASKS FOR A PORTION OF THE DAY.

Due to the executive orders for social distancing and building capacity, it is likely that school schedules will need to be altered. A hybrid model of instruction is one possible option in which students rotate between attending school and receiving remote instruction at home. Which model of rotation do you prefer?

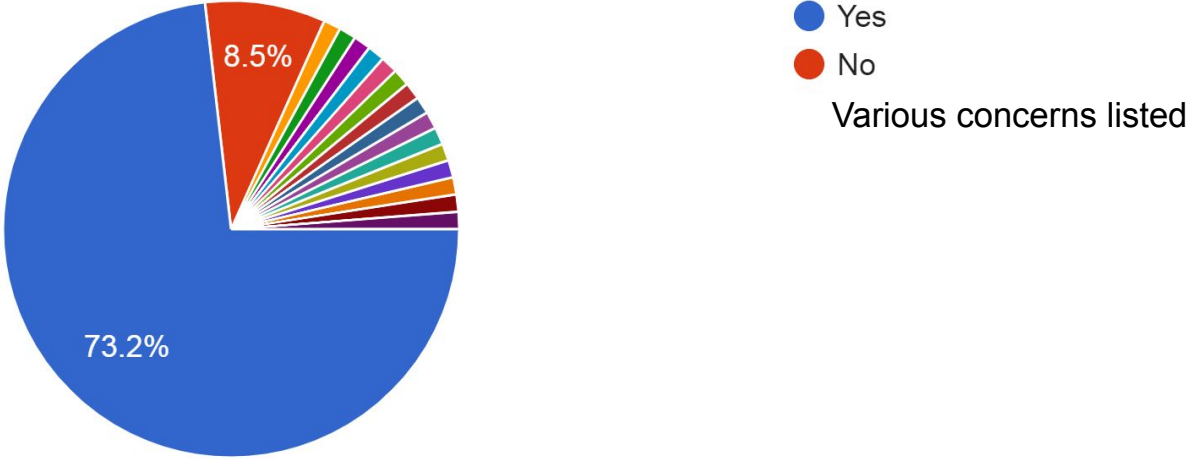

- I am not sending my child(ren) back to the school building.

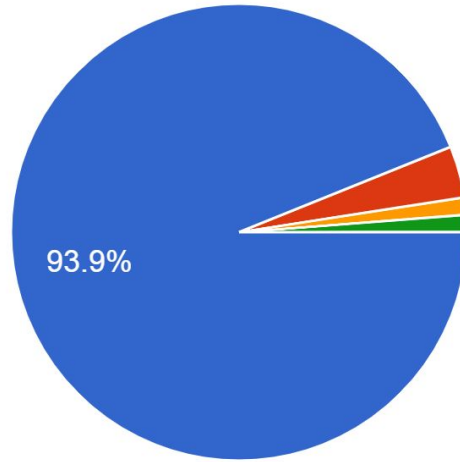
# Will your child(ren) wear a mask when directed to do so at school?

# Are you able to provide your child(ren) with masks?

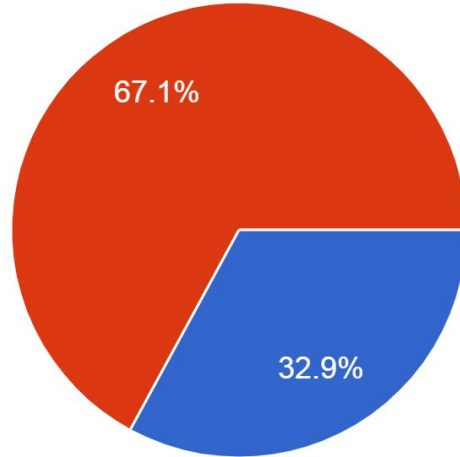
